## High School Float Trip Informational Packet

If you love having an adventure in God's creation...If you love hanging out with friends...If you love being chased by wild animals... Ok, Maybe not the last one. But if you answered yes to the first two, then you need to sign up for the High School Float Trip. This informational packet is meant to answer many of your questions.

- Where are we going?
  - We will be going to Sunburst Ranch on the Northfork River (776 County Road 352, Caulfield MO 65626). The first day we will set up camp, hangout in the river, play group games, and relax next to the campfire. The second day, we will load up in a bus travel up river and float down back to our campsite in canoes or kayaks.
- What do we eat?
  - You will need to pack a cooler with one lunch, snacks, and drinks for the river. You will also want to bring money to buy some ice from the camp store for your cooler on Sunday. No glass bottles. **MAKE SURE YOU BRING WATER!** You need more than just soda. All other meals will be provided for you.
- Where will we sleep?
  - We will be tent camping at Sunburst Ranch. This means you need to bring a tent, sleeping pad, sleeping bag, and pillow. I know many students like to sleep in a hammock. Unfortunately the flood of 2017 took down most of the trees at the campsite. There are not many if any places to put up a hammock. If you don't have a tent, we will make sure we have space for you. Please let us know on your registration form.
- What if I don't know how to float?
  - No worries. We can pair you up with an experienced canoer that can help teach you how to float.

**Where:** Sunburst Ranch (776 County Road 352, Caulfield MO 65626 | 417-284-3443)

**When:** July 17-18, 2021

**Who:** 9 – Graduated Seniors

**Cost:** \$59 for canoeing, \$69 for Kayaking

**Deadline:** July 5, 2021

**Meet:** Saturday, 10:00 am at Northside Christian Church

**Return:** Sunday, 9:00 pm at Northside Christian Church

**Please Bring:**

- Two changes of clothing to wear around the campsite
- Modest Swimsuit
  - **Girls:** Make sure your swimsuit covers your cheeks, chest, and midriff. If you want to wear a two piece, you can wear tank tops and shorts over your swimsuit on the river.
  - **Guys:** No Speedos or really short swim trunks. Guys will need to have a Tank top or shirt for the river.
- River Shoes
  - The river bed is quite rocky. It is recommended to have sandals with a heel strap, water shoes, or old tennis shoes. **DO NOT** wear Flip Flops on the river.
- Old Clothes to wear on the river. (T-Shirts or Tank Top, shorts, etc.)
- Bedding (Sleeping Pad, Sleeping Bag, and Pillow)
- Towel
- Shoes to wear around the campsite
- Toiletries (Toothbrush, Toothpaste, Soap, Shampoo, etc.)
- Sunscreen and Bug Spray
- Jacket (If it is just raining, we will still float. )
- One lunch, snacks, and drinks for the river in a cooler. Make sure you include some bottled water. You will also want a few dollars to buy some ice from the camp store before we float on Sunday.
- Bungee cords to tie the lid of your cooler shut and to tie your cooler into your canoe or kayak.
- Camping Chair (We will have some Picnic tables at the campsite)
- Tent (If you do not have a tent, please mark it on your registration form and we will make room for you)
- Pajamas or clothes to sleep in
- Water Bottle
- Football, Volleyball, Playing Cards, Spike ball, etc.
- Money for items and Ice at camp store (recommend \$10)

## Please Do Not Bring:

- Weapons, Drugs, Knives
- Alcohol, Drugs, Tobacco
- Immodest Clothing
- Prank Items

**Notes:**

We will not have access to electricity at our campsite. All electronic items like fans will need to be battery powered.
